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STUDENT'S WORKBOOK GUIDELINES

SECTION 1 - Quarterly Test

Marks obtainable: 50 marks

Time Allowed: 15 minutes

The Sunday school Coordinator (Parish/Area/Zonal) should set 10 questions from the 12 lessons in the quarter and administer them for 15 minutes. Each question carries 5 marks. Total score should be marked over 50 marks.

SECTION 2 - Quarterly Attendance in the Sunday School and Participation in Class Activities.

Marks obtainable: 50 Marks

Time allowed: 15 Minutes

Class Teachers should check the student's attendance and participations in Sunday School Class Register and count how many times the student attended the Sunday School. 4 marks should be given for each time the student was present in the Quarter, while 2 marks be given for attending the quarterly review exercise.

4 marks x number of times present plus 2 marks.

e.g $(4 \times 12) + 2 = 50$

Total scores should be marked over 50 marks.

SECTION 3 - Workbook Assignments

Marks obtainable are 100 Marks

Time Allowed: as agreed by teacher

Class Teacher should check student's workbook and obtain the student's scores. The work book assignments should be scored over 100 marks for every quarter with 10 marks for each assignment.
